Dean's plan to help end domestic violence:

- Allow law enforcement to arrest more domestic abusers and enact harsher penalties so abusers face the consequences. (A.8842)
- Supports the "Domestic Violence Protection Act," creating a registry for violent felony offenders (Brittany's Law). (A.404)
- Offer financial assistance to victims who are living in shelters or elsewhere to escape their abusers.
- Provide assistance to shelters, not-for-profits, family or friends willing to provide temporary shelter to a pet of a victim of domestic violence.
- Creation of a new "Domestic Violence in the Presence of a Child" crime with more harsh penalties for abusers. (A.8810)
- Extend orders of protection an additional two years in extreme cases. (A.8815)
- Allow domestic violence victims to obtain an emergency panic button through local social services or law enforcement.
